ALISTAIR FARSON

Alistair is a self-taught sculptor working with his trusty chainsaw and creating beautiful sculptures and furniture from wood. He is a local artist who has an affinity with local woodlands and environment. Alistair turned professional a few years ago and feels that his art improves with each project.

TED EDLEY

Based near Corfe Castle in Dorset, Ted Edley draws upon his historic automotive background to create detailed sculpture, using steel, copper, brass, aluminium and unusual found objects. Fans will find Ted's work lurking in sculpture parks as well as on TV's Salvage Hunters, The Restorers.

BEATRICE HOFFMAN

Beatrice Hoffman grew up in Munich/Germany, and arrived in this country nearly 40 years ago. She models her sculptures directly in clay, solid or coiled; or for the larger scale pieces, a steel armature is manufactured, covered with chicken wire, foam pieces and expandable foam, onto which the clay is applied. Such works are then cast into bronze or bronze resin.

PAUL HARVEY

The late Paul Harvey had an interest in birds from an early age, having kept numerous species as pets in aviaries, he was keen to carve them in wood, however their delicate features didn't lend themselves to woodcarving, so the design had to be simplified, a style that combined with his other great interest Art Deco.
