MUSICAL SITS. (Similar to Musical Chairs)

Owners with their dogs on leads walk around a circular course while music (*Hound Dog, Who Let The Dogs Out* etc) is playing.

When the music stops, owners must command their dog to sit. The last dog to do this is eliminated and the music starts again. Treats are acceptable in this game.

WHO'S YOUR MUMMY/DADDY.

This game requires each competing dog to have two handlers. The dogs line up on leads and one of the handlers walks to the other end of the ring. On the whistle the dogs are released and have to race to find their handler. Winners are the first to be clipped back on their lead.

DOG AND SPOON RACE

With your dog's lead wrapped around your wrist, you and your dog carefully weave your way through a number of cones, as you balance an egg on a teaspoon. If you drop the egg, you must stop and pick it up. Two dogs/owners go at the same time, and it is a knockout competition.

DOGGY AND OWNER LIMBO.

How low can your dog go? Dogs are split into groups of large, medium and small dog sand attempt to shimmy under the bar. Definately one for the terriers and smaller dogs to strut their stuff, though I've know spaniels who have won this game/

FANCY DRESS PARADE

The finale of the afternoon. Owners can dress their dogs in whatever costumes they want, Let your imagination soar. You will then parade around the ring to be judged.

Rosettes will be given to the top three in each of the games.
